

2009 Power To Play Sports Fall League

TEAM DISCOUNTS: Our events always reward those that enter early and commit to playing. The first 20 teams registered for the fall league will receive a \$50.00 discount for entry to be discounted during the coaches pre-season meeting.

WHAT: This is the premier fall league for northern Colorado and eastern Wyoming basketball teams in grades 5-8th grade. All games are scheduled in either back-to-back games or with one game break to ensure maximum playing time in the shortest amount of time during the day. All officials are certified high school officials, including several that work college games. The facilities are located in Windsor, Colorado and five of the six gyms are connected by one parking lot, and the sixth gym located less than 1/2 mile away (convenience of travel).

TEAMS PARTICIPATING: Teams participating include those from Fort Collins, Windsor, Loveland, Longmont, Greeley, northern Denver, Laramie and Cheyenne Wyoming, Sterling, Brush, and Eaton Colorado. When scheduling, we accommodate travel for those teams to make sure they are not playing early morning games.

SCHEDULING: The scheduling for this tournament is not a computer generated system. We manually schedule each weekend to make sure that all teams are playing in a variety of facilities, convenience for travel, and ensure competitive games for everyone. This is one of the most important features of this league that makes it different than any other in the area.

AWARDS: Medals will be awarded to the top 2 teams in each division.

WHO:

5-8th grade boys (current year)

5-8th grade girls (current year) *Added for 2009!

Due to the popularity and overwhelming success of the boys fall league, and at the suggestion of parents, we have added girls division 5-8th grade for the upcoming 2009 year.

WHEN:

All games played on Sundays. October 11, 18, 25th, November 1, 15, 22nd.

FORMAT:

2 games per weekend, playoffs on Week 6 (12 game guarantee). Teams will be split up into Tier I (highly competitive) and Tier II (mid-level and beginner level) divisions. Teams are encouraged to play in the Fall Tip-Off Tournament the week prior to this league to get a better idea of their current talent level for Tier I and Tier II divisions. This is to create a more competitive environment for all teams.

GAME TIMES:

9:00 am-6:00 pm

WHERE:

Windsor High School, Middle School, Rec. Center, Skyview Elementary, and other gyms in the northern Colorado area as needed.

COST:

\$950.00 per team. \$200.00 pre-registration is due online to reserve spot for team. First 16 teams per division will be accepted for boys, and the first 8 teams per division will be accepted for girls.

There will be no admission charge into games. Concessions are available on site at Windsor Middle School and High School.

DIVISIONS:

Number of teams in each division and structure a round robin pool play environment.

TEAMS:

5-8th grades

REGISTRATION:

Teams must register online with \$200.00 deposit by September 15th, 2009. Remaining \$750.00 is due during coaches meeting scheduled September 27th. All coaches must attend the coaches meeting or have representative and full payment or received spot will be forfeited. Schedules are released one week prior to the start of the league. \
